floral with touches of baked bread, raspberries and earthy notes

white

riesling | weingut max ferd. richter '09 | pradikatswein | mosel, germany 90

off dry riesling from germany

chenin blanc | domaine arnaud lambert '15 | clos david | samur, france 150

honey, minerality and citrus

grenache blanc | skinner '16 | el dorado california 100

single vineyard grenache blanc with a touch of oak; smells of ripe pears, fresh peaches, honey and balanced minerality

chardonnay | lutum '13 | sanford & benedict vineyard | lamboc, california 120

oaky, buttery, caramel balanced with peach, green apple & tree fruit notes

chardonnay | laurance race '16 | premier cru single vineyard | chablis, france 150

creamy but not oaky, apple, meyer lemon & stone fruits are nicely balanced with acidity and minerality

chardonnay | belle glos '20 | glasier holt vineyard | santa barbara, california 90

golden hued wine, smells of pie crust, toasted marshmallow and banana cream pie; bright acidity and balanced minerality

chardonnay | flowers '12 | sonoma coast, california (1.5bl magnum) 200

oaky chardonnay with butter, vanilla, apple, pear, citrus like lemon and lime

mission | hendry '20 | napa valley, california 90

oldest grape in california; pre prohibition this was the most planted grape; rare and special; only 1 barrel produced

pinot noir | brogen cellars '04 | andern valley, california 150

burt willima's daughter, dark fruits, prunes, raisins and oak flavors

pinot noir | ousterhout '15 | russian river, california 90

full bodied sonoma pinot noir with lots of fun fruit notes, but dry and with balanced acidity and tannins

cabernet sauvignon | louis m martini '18 | lot#1 | napa valley, california 300

leather, earth and cocoa, blackberry, plums and cassis

sangiovese | brunello di montalcino '08 | la fiorita | tuscany, italy 190

fragrant brunello, raspberries, cloves, sour cherry, fig and blackberry followed by everything you love about brunello

cab sauv+merlot+cab franc+petit verdot | chateau gloria '81 | st julien | bordeaux, france 300

and amazing tannins

vitanza '99

brunello di montalcino | tuscany, italy

smoky, new leather, chocolate,
mushrooms & forest floor;
robust tannins on the finish

cinsault

domaine des tourelles '19

bekaa, lebanon
smoky cherry and a hint of chocolate,
medium body and a lengthy finish;
first 100% cinsault I have ever tried...

cabernet pfeffer

stirm

'el gabilan' 11
cienea valley, californian
red fruit, cherry, cranberry, high acidity
gripping tannins, some forest floor,
cinnamon and earthy tones; very rare grape
